- First impressions- Create a good first impression by making the space welcoming for Children.

- Signage- Provide signage that helps parents and children navigate the space.

- Graphics- Use engaging graphics, shapes, and textures.

- Light and Color- Integrate color and light into the space.

- Organized Displays- Provide attractive and well-organized materials and displays.

- Easy Access to materials- The placement of objects impacts how children interact with them. See the environment at children's eye level.

- Flexibility- Flexibility allows you to create and recreate spaces that accommodate different functions with ease.

- Interactive Spaces- Early Learning Spaces should be interactive to encourage children to use them.
