Learning Encouragement

Continuous throughout the summer, encouraging participation in and reporting of learning activities. Example: a summer passport or bingo card that, along with reading, encourages museum visits or other activities.

Active Programs (A.P.)

One planned session conducted by a staff member, outside performer, or other programmer – it does not include informal visits to the library to report on reading, etc. Activities/crafts included in a scheduled program such as story time are not counted separately.

Self-Directed Programs (S.D.P)
