The new NY State exam for a high school equivalency diploma is called the TASC - Test Assessing Secondary Completion (formerly the SEED). The exam is free and can be taken in English and Spanish.
Passed parts of the exam already? You have until the end of 2015 before those scores expire. Find out more!

Our staff and volunteers are available to help you understand and prepare for the TASC exam. We operate at public libraries throughout the county to answer your questions and connect you with the support you need.
